The Roofing Selection Checklist includes the key questions to ask in each area and will help you choose a roofing system that meets your performance requirements.

1. Energy



- □ Does the roof meet EPA ENERGY STAR® criteria?
- □ Have potential energy savings of the roofing system been determined, using the EPA ENERGY STAR online calculator?
- □ Does the roof meet the ASHRAE 90.1 standard, making it eligible for federal tax incentives?
- ☐ In California, does the roof meet the requirements of Title 24?
- Does the roof qualify for local energy credits or tax breaks?

2. Environment



- □ Is the roof ENERGY STAR-labeled by the EPA ENERGY STAR Roof Products Program?
- □ Does the roof contribute toward green building certifications?
- ☐ Is a system/material life-cycle analysis available?
- ☐ Is the roofing material recyclable?
- ☐ Is pre-consumer production scrap generated during manufacturing, recycled?
- □ Does the roofing manufacturer have a post-consumer recycling program?
- Does the roofing system help to moderate interior temperatures in the summer and winter?
- □ Does the roofing system help deliver good indoor air quality (IAQ)?

Additional Considerations:

- How many runs to the local landfill will be needed?
- What are the anticipated costs for disposal?

3. Endurance

- □ Does the manufacturer inspect the roof after installation?
- □ Does the manufacturer have local references for this type of roofing system?
- □ Does the roofing contractor have a good reputation?
- ☐ Are contractor's employees fully-trained and supervised at the job site?
- □ Does the manufacturer train and monitor contractors and grade each installation?
- □ Does the warranty cover the entire roofing system, including installation defects?
- □ Does the warranty include coverage for ponding water or consequential damages?
- ☐ Is there a full warranty when installed over an existing roof?

Additional Considerations:

- If this roof type has failed in the past, what have been the primary reasons for system failure?
- How were failures resolved?_
- How often are routine maintenance and simple repairs required?____

4. Economics



- □ Can the manufacturer or contractor provide a life-cycle cost analysis that indicates the true long-term cost of the roofing system?
- Is this a custom, prefabricated roofing system with cost, performance, and environmental advantages?

- What are the estimated maintenance and repair costs per year?
- Is a roof tear-off required before installation? Yes No
- Does this roofing system require tear-off and disposal at the end of its service life? Yes No

5. Engineering



- ☐ Is this the best roofing system for my roof deck?
